Beginning on April 30, 2011 the New Hampshire Selectperson Institute will begin its thirteenth year as the training program available only to elected officials in New Hampshire. This popular offering is available only to sitting Selectmen throughout New Hampshire as part of an exclusive arrangement between the New Hampshire Local Government Center and Antioch New England Institute. To date more than 350 persons from 115 towns across New Hampshire have attended this popular program.

We encourage all Selectboard members, whether newly elected or experienced, to take advantage of this worthwhile program. Four day-long Saturday sessions provide you with knowledge and awareness of issues on a range of topics specific to the challenges faced by Selectboard members. You will have ample opportunity to discuss and learn from the experiences of other communities as well as from topical experts on matters important to local governance.

Last year's program filled up quickly and there was a waiting list.

The New Hampshire Selectperson Institute developed out of awareness by elected officials who, like you, had first hand knowledge of the challenges and expectations placed on the people filling this critical leadership role their communities. These civic leaders helped design a program (first offered in the Monadnock area) aimed specifically at issues routinely faced by community leaders like you. Over the years some of the focus topics have been adjusted to reflect the latest obligations and responsibilities facing Boards of Selectmen.

A brochure that describes the program schedule for this year as well as an application form are included with this letter. You are encouraged to sign up right away, as space is limited to the first 38 applicants. **Please, be sure that you can commit to attending at least three (3), preferably four (4), of the day-long Saturday sessions.** Unfortunately in past years we have reserved places for participants only to have these individuals not show, precluding others from becoming more informed Selectboard members.


