

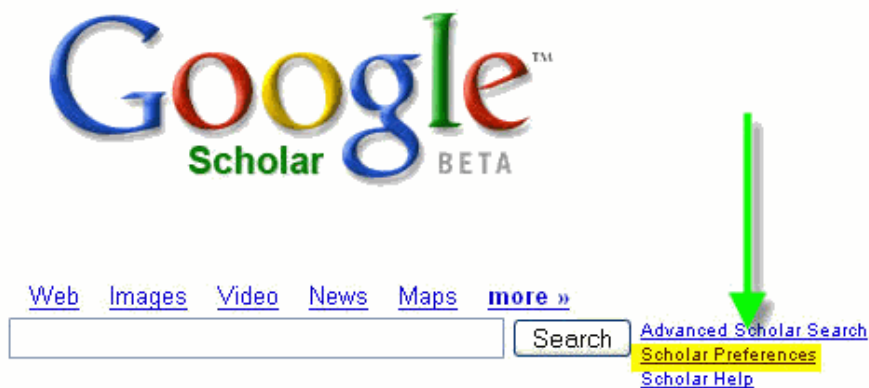

Connecting OhioLINK Databases to Google Scholar

If you use Google Scholar for your initial research into a subject, you can connect Google Scholar to OhioLINK databases in order to find the full-text of journal articles. (For books, you'll need to check Horace, the library's catalog.)

From the Google Scholar Web page (<http://scholar.google.com>), click on "Scholar Preferences."



Stand on the shoulders of giants

Under "Library Links," type "ohio" and click "find library." Then click in the check box next to OhioLINK and click "Save Preferences."

Now, when you do a search in Google Scholar, most items on the results list will include a link to connect to the OhioLINK databases, which will then let you know if the full-text of the article is available through the library's online subscriptions. The link sometimes appears next to the title:
