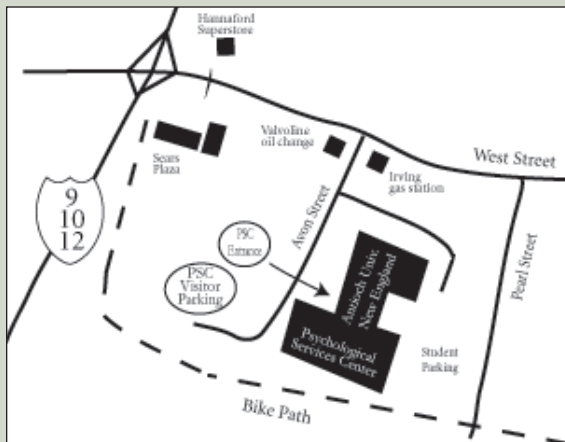

The Antioch Psychological Services Center (PSC) functions as a mental health center and offers a range of therapy, counseling, and assessment services to people in the Monadnock Region. We are staffed by a full-time director, faculty from Antioch University New England's Department of Clinical Psychology, and ten doctoral student clinicians. The PSC is a model program in professional psychology emphasizing training, supervision and staying current with changes taking place in research and service delivery in the health care field.

## TESTING AND ASSESSMENT SERVICES

The PSC is a training clinic for Antioch University New England's doctoral students in clinical psychology. We provide psychological, psycho-educational and attention deficit assessments for children, adolescents, college students and adults. Typically, our testing and assessment services address:

- Learning Disabilities
- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
- Personality
- Intellectual Abilities
- Academic Achievement
- Clinical/Diagnostic Clarity
- Intelligence Testing (IQ) for private school admission and Mensa

## PSYCHO-EDUCATIONAL ASSESSMENTS

The PSC provides assessment of learning disabilities in Reading, Writing and Mathematics, and processing deficits such as Attention Deficit Disorder and Nonverbal Learning Disability. All of our learning disability and attention deficit assessment reports meet the documentation guidelines for accommodations on the following examinations: ACT, SAT, GRE, and PRAXIS.

Our comprehensive assessment batteries include a developmental questionnaire, tests of cognitive abilities and academic achievement, behavior and study skill checklists, and a clinical interview. We can add personality testing to ADD/ADHD assessments and at a client's request when there are additional concerns about anxiety and/or depression. Parents can request that we add personality testing to their child's learning disability assessment.

The entire interview and testing process requires between 6-8 hours, which we can schedule for one full day or break up into 2-3 sessions.

## CLINICAL/DIAGNOSTIC ASSESSMENTS

Clinical/Diagnostic assessments combine individual interviews with testing results to gather information about one's cognitive abilities, personality structure, and treatment needs. A typical test battery at minimum consists of a test of cognitive abilities, a standardized personality test, and projective testing. We base the amount of information and testing that goes into each individual's assessment on the referring professional's diagnostic questions.



## FEES

Because we are a training clinic for doctoral clinical psychology students, we have very reasonable fees for our services (compared to the going rate of \$1000-\$3000 for most assessments):

- Psychological Assessment – \$400
- Psycho-educational Assessment – \$650
- Attention Deficit Disorder or NVLD – \$750
- WAIS-III or WISC-IV alone – \$250

We may adjust our fee, depending upon the purpose of the evaluation and the types of tests required. We accept MasterCard, Visa and Discover credit cards. We do not bill insurance companies.

You must pay the assessment fee in full no later than the last day of testing.
