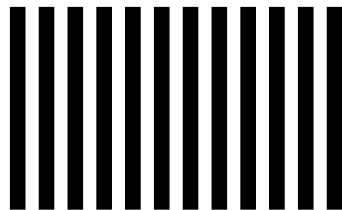




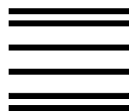

Applied Behavior Analysis Certificate Program

Behavioral training specializing in autism

Applied Behavior Analysis is the primary, evidence-based treatment for autism. Antioch University New England has developed a training program designed to meet the educational requirements for a Behavior Analyst. Strong employment markets exist for people with these credentials.

The program accommodates working professionals.

Classes are held generally one weekend a month during the five-semester span. Complete the program and earn 21 to 27 master's credits. The program starts during the fall semester.

PROGRAM DELIVERY

- Part-time, weekend program
- 21–27 credits
- 1,000-hour practicum, approximately 25 hours/week
- Tracks for post-bachelor's and post-master's
- Designed to meet the educational requirements to obtain the credentials of Behavior Analyst and Assistant Behavior Analyst

Study options are available for post-bachelor's and post-master's.

Whether you have your bachelor's or your master's, you have an option. The post-bachelor's track is designed to meet the educational requirements to become a bachelor's level (Assistant) Analyst, and the post-master's track is designed to meet the educational requirements to become a Behavior Analyst. Experience is required for credentialing.

All students must participate in a practicum or other clinical training experience with supervision, arranged by Antioch University New England, or through your current employment, if possible.
